Tucked beside the River Adur in the heart of Bramber, Little St Mary's has weathered centuries of Sussex storms — including the great flood of 1925, captured in a remarkable historic photograph. Now, a hundred years later, our team at Green Heritage & Conservation Specialists, part of Green Structural Solutions, is proud to lead the sensitive conservation and structural restoration of this Grade II listed building.

Working under the guidance of Manorwood Conservation and the local authority's heritage officers, our craftsmen are reinstating the roof, oak purlins, and flint façades using traditional lime mortars and air-dried oak — ensuring every repair honours the building's historic fabric. From rebuilding dormers by hand to stitching ancient flintwork with Helifix ties, every stage blends modern structural precision with time-honoured materials.

This project is not just about restoration — it's about safeguarding Sussex's architectural soul. What once survived the floodwaters of 1925 is now being future-proofed for generations to come.
